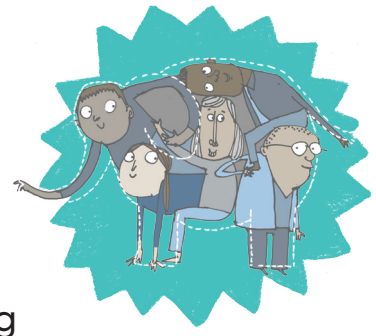


Connect Games

Human Statues

History

Significant Individuals: Christopher Columbus, Florence Nightingale, LS Lowry, Rosa Parks

Roman Gods: Neptune, Cupid, Mars, Apollo

Literacy

Punctuation Marks: Full stop, Exclamation Mark, Dash, Parentheses

Favourite characters: Ask the children for some of their personal favourites, and whether they can suggest a statue to represent their choice. Select four to use in play.

Science

Minibeasts: Bee, Snail, Scorpion, Caterpillar

Inventors: Edison, Dyson, Bell, Ford

Note:

- *Do the children know what each of the above invented? Discuss this first, basing the statues on the inventions rather than inventors.*

Geography

Geographical Features: River, Volcano, Iceberg, Waterfall

Landmarks: Stonehenge, Eiffel Tower, Great Pyramid of Giza, Statue of Liberty

Note:

- *When 'designing' the statues themselves it really helps to ensure that they are clearly identifiable. Use characters at different levels and with very specific gestures to ensure they are distinguishable.*
